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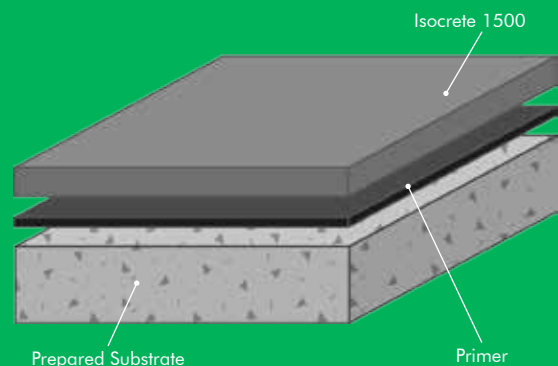

Products Included In This System

Primer:	Isocrete Primer at 200-250 sq ft/gal
Mortar:*	Isocrete 1500 at 25 sq ft/bag at 3/16"

Mortar consists of 50 lb bag Isocrete 1500 and 5 quartz of cool potable water. An additional pint of water may be added if required.

*Yield with 50% extension by weight with 3/8" clean pea gravel - 0.6 cubic foot (for applications over 1" depth)

Coverages listed are theoretical, actual coverages may vary based on substrate and site variations. Detailed application instructions are available upon request.

Installation

Installation should be carried out by a Flowcrete STAR or preferred contractor with a documented quality assurance note. Obtain details of our preferred contractor network from our customer service team or by enquiring through our website. Detailed application instructions are also available upon request.

Substrate Requirements

Concrete or screed substrate should have a minimum of 3,000 psi compressive strength, free from laitance, dust and other contamination. The substrate should be dry to ASTM requirements and free from excessive moisture vapor transmission.

Protection on Completion

Ensure the screed is not subject to drafts during the first 6 hours of curing as this may lead to cracking and crazing. Tape up doorways with polythene to prevent air movement. Prevent contamination by following trades, e.g. plastering, including water spillage.

Technical Profile

The figures and test results shown overleaf are typical properties achieved in laboratory tests at 75°F and at 50% Relative Humidity.

Environmental Health & Safety

The finished system is assessed as non-hazardous to health and the environment. The long service life and seamless surface reduce the need for repairs and maintenance. Environmental and health considerations are controlled during manufacture and application of the products by Flowcrete Americas' staff and fully trained application teams.

Drying Time

Moisture sensitive floor finishes can be installed when the screed is dry to 75% RH when tested with a moisture meter like a Delmhorst or Tramex, typically after 24 hours, dependent on ambient conditions. Allow product to harden without drafts then ensure the area has sufficient ventilation to allow the screed to dry.
